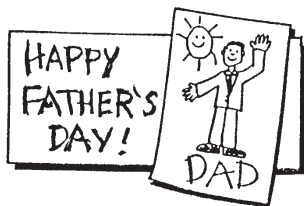

Dear Friends,

Happy Fathers Day to all fathers! We thank you for being our fathers, and promise our prayers for you. May God our Father (and Mother) bless you and keep you true to your vocation.

Last weekend a parishioner asked if we had communion wafers that were gluten-free for anyone suffering from celiac disease. I said, "Yes, of course." When I arrived at SEAS in 2004 someone asked if we could get hosts that were gluten-free. We searched and found a church-approved place and have offered them to anyone requesting them. If you are in such a situation that you need them, ask myself or the sacristan on duty on the weekend to show you what to do so that communion is available to you at Mass.

This coming Tuesday, June 22, at 7:00PM in Seton Hall, the Haiti Committee, made up of those who either viewed my Haiti slides and/or came to the meeting with representatives from H.O.P.E., will meet to discuss our future involvement with H.O.P.E. If you did not attend either meeting, please know that anyone from the parish is welcome to participate in this new parish ministry. The Pastoral Council, at its May meeting, officially approved our involvement with H.O.P.E. for at least the next three years.

Also on June 22, Archbishop Timothy Dolan, Archbishop of New York, will be the presider at the Mass honoring the priests of the diocese who are celebrating their 25th and 50th Anniversary of their Ordination. The Mass will take place at 10:30AM at Sacred Heart Cathedral on Flower City Park in Rochester. All are welcome. It will also be the feast of St. John Fisher, the first bishop of Rochester, England, and the patron saint of our diocese.

Please plan on attending and honoring Deacon Chris and his wife, Lynn, next weekend after the 10:30AM Mass. A Dish to Pass Brunch Picnic will take place after Mass. Bring your favorite dish to share with others from the parish and wish Deacon Chris and Lynn continued blessings in their journey of faith. We will continue to see them worship here at SEAS, and want to thank them for their service here these past twelve years.

Speaking of deacons, we are still awaiting word if we will have a new deacon with us during this coming year. We will hopefully hear very soon.

Tonight our Finance Council met to review our current budget and finalize our budget for 2010-2011 for Pastoral Council to approve on June 28. Among the items being discussed for next year is getting new carpeting for the church. Many have said we need it after 24 years of use. We are considering using funds from our Maintenance and Development Accounts to purchase the new carpeting. Any thoughts?
