You will find in today's bulletin a copy of some Guidelines for Electronic Communication which our staff and Pastoral Council have approved for SEAS. The communication ministry over the years here has provided different methods of communication with the goal to share events and activities with the SEAS Family. Over the years this has included our weekly bulletin, our website (myseas.org), quarterly newsletters and e-mails. Unfortunately, the website does not have much traffic and the quarterly newsletter was discontinued due to low interest.

At the end of last year the Diocese of Rochester provided Guidelines for Electronic Communication with Children, Youth and Vulnerable Adults. The document states, "Electronic communication (Social networking sites, instant messaging, e-mail, text messaging, cellular phone and the like) will continue to grow in sophistication and usefulness. They are already a preferred means of communication among youth and Young adults."

The use of social media, such as Twitter and Facebook, is proving to be a technology trend that churches can rely on to help them interact with and keep their members informed. Recent studies are showing that Facebook is overtaking the use of e-mail. The Diocese of Rochester has been using Twitter and Facebook.
