**Dear Friends,**

We welcome Father Edwin “Ted” Metzger to our parish this weekend. Father Ted is now retired and living at Mother of Sorrows Church in Greece and helping at Holy Name of Jesus Church in Greece. He will be periodically helping here at SEAS during the coming year. I have know Father Ted since my days as a student at St. Bernard’s Seminary, beginning in 1969. He has been a good and loyal friend to me.

Last weekend all of us who were present for the 5:00PM Mass were very happy to see Bishop Clark preside on the 31st Anniversary of his being consecrated Bishop of Rochester at the Rochester War Memorial in 1979. As I mentioned at that Mass, Bishop Clark will be 75 in July, 2012, when he will submit his retirement letter to the Pope. So with 2 years left before he retires, we hope he will be able to come back and join us for an entire weekend. I will work on that.

This past weekend we as a parish thanked Deacon Chris and Lynn for their 12 years of service to us. We will continue to see both of them as they will be worshipping here at SEAS. Thank you, Chris and Lynn, for your ministry and service among us.

Please plan on welcoming Deacon Jim Steiger to our parish on July 10/11. Jim lives with his wife, Carol, in Hilton. He will be sharing the preaching schedule with me, along with preparing couples for their children’s baptisms, assisting in some Pre-Cana preparations, working with the Faith Formation Committee, and participating in Staff meetings. I look forward to working with him.

Last evening the Pastoral Council met for the final time in this fiscal year. I wish to thank Wayne Dreyer, Leslie Zink, Chris Sherry, and Emily Palmeri for their work on the Council. The June meeting always has as its main agenda item the approval of a new budget for the coming fiscal year. The proposed budget was passed unanimously. It totals \$341,320, an increase of \$10,000+ over last year’s budget. Part of this amount is the new ministry agreed upon at the May meeting. \$2600 will be raised and given as part of our work with H.O.P.E. More details about this will be forthcoming from the committee that was formed to oversee SEAS role. Jerry Clement and Bob Flanagan are the co-chairs of this new committee.

Also, Kathi Noon and Joey Conlon were elected auditors of the parish for the coming year, and Patty Duffy and Jim Joyce were elected trustees of the parish corporation for the coming year.

The following goals were chosen by the Council members for the coming year:

- *Increase attendance at Whole Community Catechesis both youth and adults. Increase awareness that it is for the Whole Community.*
- *Continue to promote the spirit of stewardship within the Parish through the TT&T committee.*
- *Support Parish involvement in the SEAS-HOPE collaboration.*
- *Strengthen leadership for liturgical ministers in order to encourage increased participation.*
- *Increase SEAS younger members in Ministries that support Mass; i.e. Lector, Usher, Eucharistic Minister.*
- *Continue to promote the Breakfast Club as a time for all parishioners to become better acquainted and attempt to develop a sense of community and caring among us.*

The first meeting of the new Pastoral Council will take place on Monday, July 26, when new officers will be elected.
