Dear Friends,

I had a wonderful time with family and friends in my hometown of Whiting, Indiana, last week. I stayed with my oldest brother, Joe, who lives in the house we both grew up in for most of our lives. My father, who was a brick mason, built the house with the help of other family members and friends. (I was only four years of age when the house was being built. So my help was very limited.)

Besides my brother, Joe, I also have another brother, Richard, who is married and lives in southern California. I have only two aunts living, one is 95 (my mother's youngest sister). Her name is Clara, and she lives by herself in the house that she and her husband lived in until his death in 2001. My other aunt, Mildred, is 87 (my father's youngest sister), and she lives in her own house with her eldest son. I spent much time with both of them and some of my cousins. Whenever I go home, visiting is a very important part of my vacation.

I also participated at Mass in my home church, St. John the Baptist, where I made my first communion, was confirmed, and where I celebrated my first Mass and presided at the funerals of my Mom and Dad and other family members. In the past few years, this parish of St. John became clustered with three other churches in the community with one pastor. The parochial grade school, which when I attended had over 1000 students in the 1950's, now has just over 300 students.

All in all, with two days spent driving back and forth, the five days I spent visiting and being with family and friends were delightful.

Unfortunately, when I returned home to SEAS, I was confronted with the fact that three days of my mail were stolen from our front office. We have tried to ascertain what was taken and when it was taken. It had to have occurred on Saturday, July 3, because Billie Dietrich had the mail on her desk on Friday, and no one saw any mail on her desk on Sunday. We have had some items from parishioners and myself taken out of the bride's room during Midnight Mass and at other Masses since then. Cards were taken out of my sweater at Midnight Mass and money was taken from a parishioner's purse.

We have implemented more stringent security measures with our sacristans since these thefts took place, and yet this latest theft of my mail has meant that someone is still bold enough to steal in our church. If anyone has any information regarding these thefts, please contact me as soon as possible. This kind of behavior should not be taking place in our homes, let alone here in our church. Pray for the person(s) who has this sickness.
