Father Justine Elias, V.C., a Vincentian Missionary Priest from India, will be here next weekend to participate in our Annual Diocesan Missionary Cooperative Plan. He will preach at all the Masses and a second collection will be taken up for the Vincentian Missions in India.

The Vincentian Congregation (V.C.), a religious congregation, was founded in Kerala, Indian in 1904, modeled after the Congregation of the Mission founded by St. Vincent de Paul. Members of this flourishing religious congregation, all natives of India, are engaged in mission work in all parts of India and in East Africa.

The Vincentian Missionaries need our help to carry out their many missionary, educational and charitable activities. They need our special financial support for the training of young men for the priesthood and their ministry to the people in India.

Niagara University in Niagara Falls, New York, is run by the Vincentian Fathers. And our Joey Conlon is secretary/bookkeeper in the Diocesan Missions Office at the Pastoral Center on Buffalo Road.

On Monday, July 26, we will celebrate the feast of Saints Joachim and Anne, parents of Mary, and grandparents of Jesus. Special devotion have always been given to these important saints in our church. We will have a our regular 9:00AM Mass in the chapel, as well as, Mass for our Pastoral Council at 7:00PM in the chapel. Please join us for either Mass to honor Sts. Joachim and Anne.

Speaking of our Pastoral Council, this will be the first meeting of our new council for this year. Election of officers and some organizational items will take place at this meeting. The Council meets on the fourth Monday of each month, except in August and December.
